WHAT'S INCLUDED

SITA program fees are intended to cover all your expenses once you are in India.

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| living stipend | students receive a stipend to help defray the cost of lunch, purchasing clothes, local travel |
| extracurriculars | students receive support to cover the cost of expressive culture classes |
| research support | students are able to work with translators to help with language & logistics of their research |
| tours | students participate in one 6-day tour to Kerala and a variety of long-weekend tours; all travel and entry fees are covered by SITA |
| coursework | includes course readers or books (lended); travel & entry fees for field visits & practicums; free printing for coursework and research is also made available to students |
| wi-fi | free wi-fi is available at the SITA Center |
| meals | breakfast & dinner with host family; one lunch/week at the SITA Center; a stipend to cover other lunches & meals while on tours |
| insurance | reimbursement for medical and mental health expenses incurred in India; assistance for travel emergencies (lost passport, etc.); legal support if required; evacuation support |
| transcript | a George Washington University transcript is provided |

Withdrawal and Refund Policy

Please note that withdrawing from the program within 6 weeks of the arrival date will have financial consequences.

- If you withdraw on or before June 30, 2017: 100% refund of the total program cost, except the non-refundable program deposit of \$500.
- If you withdraw July 1 – July 14, 2017: 90% refund of the total program cost, except the non-refundable program deposit of \$500.
- If you withdraw July 15 – July 28, 2017: 75% refund of the total program cost, except the non-refundable program deposit of \$500.
- If you withdraw July 29 – Aug. 11, 2017: 50% refund of the total program cost, except the non-refundable program deposit of \$500.
- If you withdraw on or after Aug. 12, 2017: no refund will be issued.
